A Cybersecurity Technologist manages and deals with cyber threats, hazards and risks to protect organisations, systems and people from harm.

People in this occupation work to achieve required security outcomes in a legal and regulatory context in all parts of the economy. They develop and apply practical knowledge of information security to deliver solutions that fulfil an organisation's requirements.

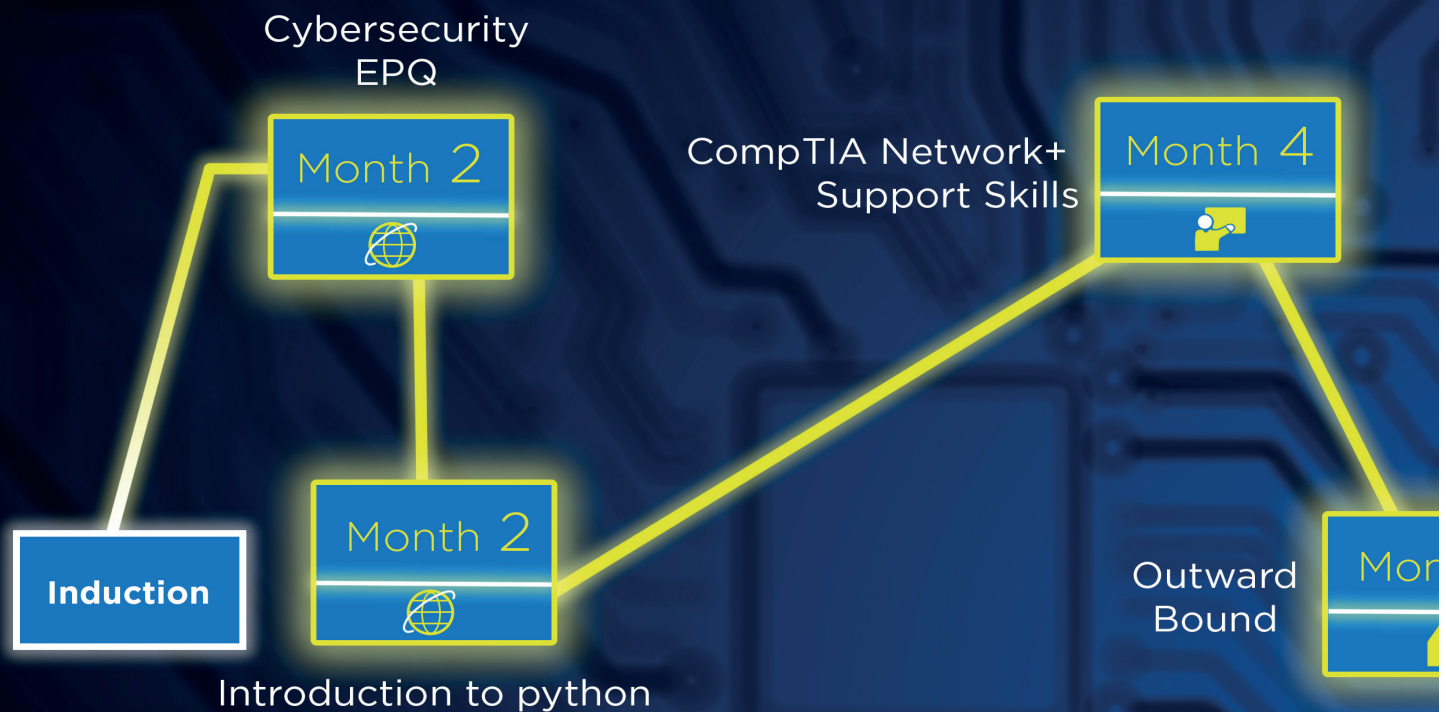
Entry Level Requirements: Individual employers will set the selection criteria, but this is likely to include 'A' Levels, a relevant Level 3 apprenticeship, or other relevant qualifications, relevant experience and/or an aptitude test with a focus on functional maths.

Qualifications: The apprentice via this technologist route must achieve a minimum of five knowledge modules outlined below and will be supported via the training incorporated into the 'Learner Journey'.

- Cybersecurity Introduction
- Network and Digital Communications Theory
- Security Case Development and Design Good Practice
- Security Technology Building Blocks
- Employment of Cryptography

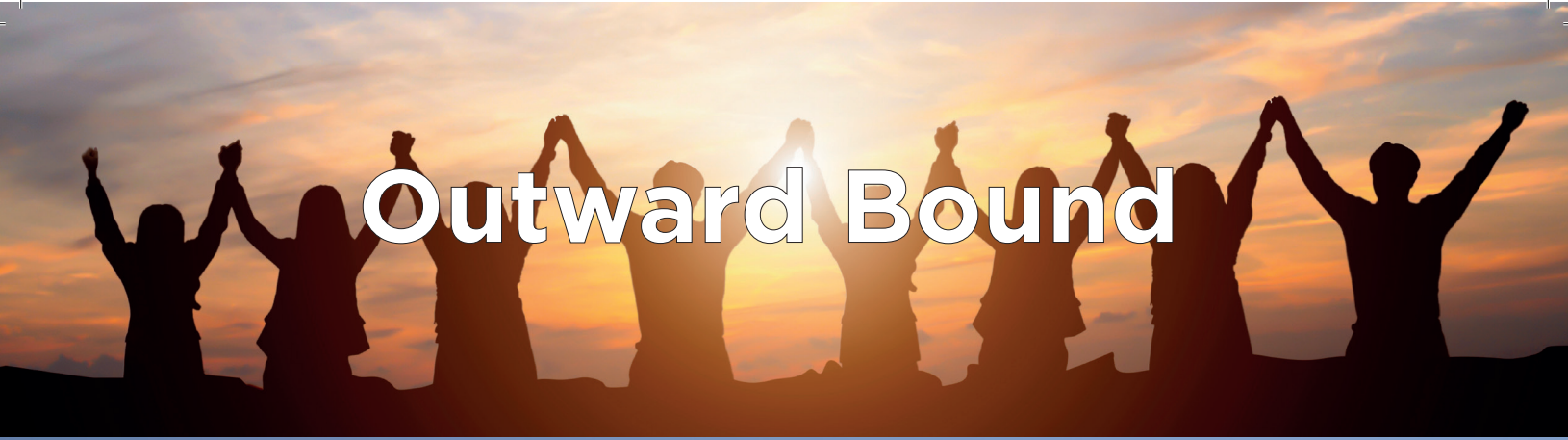

Outward Bound

The Outward Bound is an opportunity available via an exclusive partnership with GK Apprenticeships. It is an outdoor practical character-building learning opportunity; it focuses on sharpening our apprentices workplace behaviour. Our mission is to reinforce strengths and pinpoint key areas of improvement which are applicable throughout their work-life. We achieve this through team-based challenges, practical problem-solving, and hard work.

The goals and objectives of the Outward Bound programme are as follows:

- Develop an understanding of positive workplace behaviours in-line with behavioural matrix's attached to the individual's apprenticeship.
- Create an action plan to take forward into the workplace relating to personal behaviours.

This fun, action-packed, team building and educational experience is supported by an educational charity, who help people defy limitations through learning and adventures in the wild.

Accommodation:

Apprentices will need to arrive on the 1st day by 14:00 and leaving on the 4th day by 13:00.

Course accommodation for the three nights is £150 + VAT per learner.

All sustenance is included in the course cost. This does not include anything purchased whilst travelling to and from the course, (this also does not include alcohol).

NB: All travel and accommodation costs will need to be funded by the employer and therefore it is the employer's decision to take advantage of this incorporated learning solution. Other methods are available upon request; however, they will not offer your apprentice the same experience.

20% off-the-job

As with all apprenticeship delivery there is a regulated requirement to allow amount of 20% 'off-the-job'. It is the responsibility of both the training partner and employer to ensure that this is managed.

Off-the-job relates to any training attendance, coaching and development sessions provided by both the training partner or the employer through shadowing, guidance and mentoring. It is also in place to ensure that the apprentice can reflect on their learning and how they apply their newly acquired knowledge back into their job role. Therefore, the apprentice is expected to use the time provided to them via their employer effectively.

The required 20% off-the-job of this programme is based on the 21 month's learning that will be undertaken prior to the End Point Assessment. The total target is equivalent to a minimum 1 day per week based on 84 weeks.
